Special Budget Meeting Minutes
October 25, 2022

A Special Budget Meeting of the Lower Oxford Township Board of Supervisors was held at the Township Building located at 220 Township Road, on Tuesday, October 25, 2022.

The following were in Attendance: Supervisors: Kevin R. Martin, Noël A. Roy, Robert McMahon, Roadmaster, Steven C. Price; and Secretary/Treasurer, Deborah J. Kinney. No guests were in attendance.

Mr. Martin, called the Special Budget Meeting of the Board of Supervisors meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

Mr. Martin called for recognition of those asking to appear on the agenda. There were none.

The Board of Supervisors discussed and deliberated the proposed 2023 budget for the General Fund, State Fund, Open Space Fund.

Mr. Roy made a motion to break from the meeting at 9:51 a.m. to join a zoom meeting with FEMA regarding the Calvary Road Bridge. Mr. McMahon seconded the motion. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Martin reconvened the budget hearing meeting at 10:15 a.m.

Discussion continued regarding the General Fund Income and Expenditures.

Mr. Martin called for an executive session at 10:45 a.m.

Mr. Martin reconvened the budget hearing meeting at 10:55 a.m.

Mr. Roy moved to approve the 2023 proposed budget as presented. Mr. McMahon seconded the motion. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. McMahon moved to adjourn the meeting at 11:00 a.m. Mr. Roy seconded the motion. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.
